SAE International Student Study Grants Terms and Conditions	
1. Policy Statement	This policy outlines the terms and conditions applicants, students and staff abide by when applying or receiving financial Grants at SAE Institute Pty Ltd trading as SAE Creative Media Institute (SAE)
2. Purpose	This policy and procedure is to define the principles of the International Study Grants at SAE, when, how and who may access the Grant and the main conditions applying to them.
3. Scope	These guidelines apply to all SAE Campuses and the application Grants associated with the Study Grants.

6. Policy

6.1 General Terms and Conditions

SAE Study Grants are awarded in line with the following terms and conditions:

- The recipient is the sole holder of the Grant in a specified course;
- The recipient of Study Grant must be enrolled into a Bachelor course and maintain a full time study load
- The recipient must be an international student, residing within Australia and hold an international student visa
- Recipients must adhere to all Student Visa Conditions specified on their student visa grant notice, including maintaining course progression and attendance and are subject to being reported for visa noncompliance. Student visa holders who are reported for breach and have their enrollment at SAE cancelled will also have their Study Grant cancelled.
- The Grant must be taken within the specified term and cannot usually be deferred for a period longer than 12 months, except where the recipient may request consideration of a deferral due to Special Circumstances.
- The recipient must not be the holder of another Grant or Scholarship within the same period of time.
- The Grant will be paid in installments to the recipient within 14 days after the financial census date of the first three trimesters.
- The recipient is required to pay the tuition fees in full to receive the study grant
- All recipients of all awards must maintain satisfactory attendance and a high academic standard across all units of study.
- Receiving a Fail grade in any unit of study may result in review or termination of the Grant.
- Recipients agree to be profiled for marketing and promotion purposes. This may include, but not limited to, providing photos and profile information for SAE's website, newsletters, advertising, and other marketing collateral;
- Grants entitle the recipient to undertake approved units of study from the course in which the Grant is held, and
- Grant funds are used at the discretion of the recipient, though are intended to support the cost of living whilst they study.
- Other eligibility criteria may apply as indicated in the application form.
- Should Grant holders fail to meet any condition, the Grant may be reviewed or terminated.

Note: The Institute is not obliged to award a Grant if it is determined that there were no suitable commencing student applicants.

6.2: Revocation of Grants

SAE reserves the right to revoke a Grant under the following conditions;

- Breach of International Student Policy
- A breach of the SAE Code of Conduct
