1 | EMAIL DOCUMENTS

 Download and fill in the International Student Enrolment Form and email to international.admissions@sae.edu. Please include a copy of your passport, academic documents and evidence of your English language competency.

2 | RECEIVE YOUR OFFER

- International Admissions will review and assess your application and if all is in order, will email you a Letter of Offer. If you are using an education agent, your offer will be sent to your agent.
- An offer may include conditions that must be met, before your enrolment can be approved.
- If you have requested advanced standing or credit (Recognition of Prior Learning - RPL), we will help you to apply for this before you receive your course offer.

3 | ACCEPT YOUR OFFER

When your application has been approved, you will be asked to:

- · Sign a Student Admissions Agreement.
- · Pay a tuition deposit.
- · Arrange OSHC (Overseas Student Health Cover).

4 | FINALISE YOUR ENROLMENT

 Your study placement is confirmed when you receive an electronic Confirmation of Enrolment (eCoE). An eCoE is required before you can apply for your Student Visa. If you are using an education agent, your eCoE will be sent to your agent.

5 | APPLY FOR YOUR VISA

As part of this requirement, you may be interviewed by the International Admissions Coordinator and asked to provide additional information to demonstrate your suitability for a student visa. You may also be asked to provide a "Statement of Purpose".
