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Exposing issues around youth mental health

Exposure Live is a new video-on-demand service supporting positive mental health in our youth. The platform delivers high quality video recordings of live, youth-theatre performances along with teaching resources for schools, universities, parents, and youth and mental health organisations across Australia, giving them the opportunity to engage young people in meaningful discussions about issues that affect them directly.

Recent Headspace studies indicate that high school students are experiencing higher levels of stress, anxiety and depression over the past two years as they grapple to deal with the global issues affecting them.

Co-founder of Exposure Live, Lisa Apostolides stated how important it is for young people to have a safe environment to share about mental health and realise they are not alone.

"The performances on Exposure Live reflect real life scenarios of young people experiencing mental health issues. The conversations need to be had in as many settings as possible to provide the support our youth need. We always advise teachers, facilitators and parents to check all materials before sharing, to be mindful of timing, setting and having additional support."
