SAE Creators in Technology 25T2 Terms and Conditions

1. Policy Statement	This policy outlines the terms and conditions for applicants, students, and staff applying for or receiving financial Scholarships at SAE Institute Pty Ltd, trading as SAE University College (SAE).
2. Purpose	This policy defines the principles and outlines the conditions of the Creators in Technology Scholarship (Scholarship) for the Trimester 2, 2025
3. Scope	These guidelines apply to Domestic undergraduate Students on all SAE Campuses in Australia, and the courses and application associated with the Scholarship.

6. Policy	<p>6.1 Eligibility Requirements</p> <p>Scholarships are awarded based on merit, determined by the quality of a formal written submission and portfolio assessment. To be eligible for a scholarship, applicants must provide SAE with a 250-word statement which addresses the question - <i>“Describe a project or challenge you have worked on (in computer science or VFX) that you are particularly proud of. How did it inspire your interest in the field, and how do you plan to use your skills to contribute to the future of technology or visual storytelling?”</i></p> <p>In addition to this, applicants may also submit a portfolio to support their application. This can be provided by way of URL or a physical submission. In the case of a physical submission, note that these will not be returned.</p> <p>Scholarship recipients will be assessed by SAE faculty.</p> <p>6.2 General Terms and Conditions</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The recipient is the sole holder of the Scholarship. • The Scholarship is only valid for new domestic students enrolling in the Trimester 2, 2025 intake. Students who defer their studies to a future intake will no longer be eligible for the Scholarship.

- Recipients of the Scholarship must be enrolled into an eligible Bachelor course and maintain a minimum study load to 30 credit points per trimester
- The Scholarship is applied to tuition fees each trimester to a value \$2,000 per trimester up to a maximum of \$12,000.
- The Scholarship cannot be transferred or exchanged for cash.
- Recipients are required to adhere to the tuition payment provisions outlined in the Tuition Fees and Refund Policy.
- Applications for Trimester 2, 2025 close **16 May 2025**.
- Both successful and unsuccessful applicants will be notified within one week of application via email.
- Each application will be assessed on a case-by-case basis. Scholarship decisions are made at the sole discretion of SAE University College, are final and not subject to appeal.
- All recipients of the scholarship must maintain satisfactory attendance of 75% across all enrolled units of study in each Trimester.
- Receiving a Fail grade in any unit of study may result in review or termination of the scholarship.
- Recipients of the scholarship agree to be profiled for marketing and promotional purposes. This may include but not limited to providing photos and profile information for SAE's website, newsletters, advertising, and other marketing collateral.
- Recipients of the Scholarship agree to undertake ambassador duties for 5 hours per trimester. This may include, but is not limited to:
 - attendance and participation at events including expos, open days, info nights, and other campus initiatives.

Note:

- SAE is not obliged to award the scholarship if it is determined that there were no suitable commencing student applicants.

6.3: Revocation of Scholarships

SAE reserves the right to revoke the Scholarship under the following conditions:

- a breach of the SAE Code of Conduct, including providing false or misleading information on the application
- breach of the Academic Integrity Policy
- being placed on Academic Probation as per the Student Progression Policy
- cancellation or withdrawal of their enrolment at SAE
- once the full value of the scholarship has been paid
- if a recipient of the named Scholarship transfers to another course not eligible for the scholarship
