

SAE University College Genuine Student (GS) Requirement Assessment

As part of the assessment of your application for admission to SAE University College, you are required to respond to the following Genuine Student (GS) questions. Each response should be no more than 150 words.

1. Give details of your current circumstances.

Your statement must include the following:

- Family composition - members of the family, description of any jobs / businesses and siblings'
 - Occupations, any ties to the community.
 - A brief description of the family's liquid and immovable assets.
 - Details of your employment (if any) – name of the company, nature of operations, position, salary, size of the company, duration of the employment.
 - Address any gaps in employment or education.
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2. Explain why you wish to study this course at SAE University College.

Your statement must include the following:

- Which countries did you compare and why you chose Australia as your study destination.
 - What course and provider options did you research in Australia.
 - Demonstrate your understanding of the intended course, what you expect to learn and what aspects of the course interest you the most.
 - Reasons for not doing a similar course in your home country.
 - Brief explanation of your funding options and planned living arrangements in Australia including rental costs, accommodation type, arrangements for travel to-and-from campus. If living with a relative, clearly state distance from the campus, type of accommodation, family composition of the relatives, whether sharing any rent.
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3. Explain how completing the course will be of benefit to you.

Your statement must include the following:

- Is the course consistent with your current level of education.
 - Explain how the course will assist you to obtain employment or improve employment prospects in your home country or another country. If the intended course is unrelated to previous studies or at the same level as your previous studies, then explain reasons for your choice.
 - Explain expected salary and other benefits in your home country or another country obtained with the qualifications from the proposed course of study.
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4. Give details of any other relevant information you would like to include.

(Optional) Your statement may include the following:

- Your and your spouse's (if applicable) details of all immigration history (including Australia and other countries). This will include details of all successful and/or unsuccessful visa applications, any visa cancellations, any deportations, any attempts to seek asylum or any other immigration history. Please address concerns in case of adverse immigration history.
 - If you have relative(s) in Australia – provide their location, type of visa, profession, type of relation (sister, uncle, cousin, etc.).
 - Any other information that may be of relevance.
